This year we intend to have doctors, specialists and volunteers from Andhra Pradesh, Tamil Nadu and UK participating in the medical camp. In addition to the medical consultations, we intend to provide a basic biochemical diagnostic service too. Health promotion sessions will be held on diabetes and women's health issues to create public awareness.

This camp will be conducted by Arulananda Trust (AP, India) with the support of Sri Yoga Hanuman Trust (UK).
